



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can my partner and I attend the program together?

No. There are separate groups for men and women but no mixed groups.

Does the assessment determine if I am accepted into the program?

No. The pre and post assessments are intended to measure your progress. While they are required, they do not determine if you are accepted into the program.

Are all the participants “court ordered?”

No. Some participants are self-referred or voluntary. They have to follow the same rules as the participants that are court ordered.

What does the program cost?

The initial assessment costs \$200.00. The first 13 groups cost \$35.00 each; The second set of 13 groups costs \$25.00 each and the 3rd set of 13 groups costs \$20.00; The final 13 groups are free (unless you attend a make-up group) Make-up groups during the last 13 weeks costs \$20.00 each.

What if I don't have the money to pay for the assessment or the group; Is any assistance available?

There is no assistance available as the program is entirely self-supporting. If you cannot attend a group, you are counted absent. If you have 3 consecutive absences or a total of 7 during the 52 weeks, you are dropped from the program and referred back to the Court.

How do I pay for the assessment and the groups?

Payments can be made online using PayPal at <https://www.survivorresourcenetwork.org/thetimeisnow.html#/> Those without credit/debit cards can pay via money order or cash. Checks are **NOT** accepted.

Are make-up groups available?

Yes. A make-up group is available each week.

What would count as an excused absence from group?

Military service or hospitalization are the only 2 “excused” absences allowed by law.

What if I have to leave group early?

If you leave a group early, it is counted as an absence.

If I have 6 absences do I only have to attend 46 of the 52 groups?

No. Law requires that each participant must attend a total of 52 groups.

What should I do if I realize I cannot attend a group that I am supposed to?

Call to schedule a make-up group that will be offered that same week.
